My recent adventures with ceramics have been unexpectedly fun. I like to use my painting background to design and decorate my ceramics. Using carving tools like brushes and a variety of underglazes to illustrate the same way I do with my watercolors. Clay offers a dimensional and tactile way of interacting with what I'm creating and I enjoy the useful aspect of the completed pieces. My art varies wildly but not randomly as I explore the wide range of possibilities. There is so much more to learn but I'm enjoying the ride. I hope your journey is just as lovely."
